



Service Area Guidelines Re: Eligibility

To apply to the Family Connections Program, you need to attend an [approved institution](#) within King, Pierce, or Snohomish Counties, as well as reside in King, Pierce, or Snohomish (KPS) Counties. Exceptions will be made on a case-by-case basis for residing in directly neighboring counties, and the guidelines below will help you determine your eligibility.

Eligible

- Student lives in KPS counties and is enrolled at an [approved institution](#).
- Student lives in KPS counties and is enrolled at a satellite college campus located in KPS counties. Example: Washington State University at Everett Campus or Eastern Washington University at Bellevue College.
- Student lives just outside of KPS counties and is enrolled at and goes to in-person courses at a KPS college. Example: Student lives in Lacey, WA and goes to Pierce College.

Not Eligible

- Student lives in KPS counties and goes to a college campus not located in KPS counties. Example: Student lives in KPS counties and takes an online degree at Washington State University.
- Student lives outside of KPS and goes to KPS college online degree. Example: Student lives in Oregon and is enrolled at University of Washington for an online certificate.
- Student lives out of KPS counties and is enrolled at a college not in KPS counties.
